



Glenn Segars Scholarship

This scholarship is administered by the Barrow Community Foundation Inc and will be made to a graduating senior from Barrow County's public high schools. The student must be a Barrow County resident, and be enrolled in or accepted at an accredited four year college or university. The student must show success in academics, demonstrate involvement in his/her community, and have a need for this scholarship. For those winning the scholarship, the Barrow Community Foundation will mail a check to the registrar at the college or university in the student's name. Scholarships range from \$500-\$1000.

This scholarship was established in 1999 by the estate Mrs. Anne Segars in memory of her late husband, Mr. Glenn Segars. Mr. Segars was a student member and officer of the first Future Farmers of America Chapter chartered in the State of Georgia in 1929 at Statham High School in Barrow County. Mr. Segars would become a Vocational Agriculture teacher in Barrow County Schools, and later the Assistant Commissioner of Agriculture for the State of Georgia.
