



W. H. Jennings Memorial Scholarship

The W. H. Jennings Memorial Scholarship is administered by the Barrow Community Foundation Inc. This scholarship was established in 2001 in memory of Mr. W.H. Jennings' business & community leadership and his legacy in the Barrow community. Mr. Jennings' preference was to recognize someone looking to attend one of the local Technical Colleges, however the scholarship will be presented to a college-bound student as appropriate. An annual award of \$500-\$1000 will be made to a graduating senior from Winder-Barrow High School. The student must be enrolled in or accepted to an accredited college, university or technical college.

Mr. Jennings' sons, Don and Tommy Jennings, will assist in reviewing applications, and make a recommendation as part of the BCF Scholarship Committee. The winner will be recognized during WBHS Spring Awards Day. The Barrow Community Foundation Inc. will mail the scholarship check of \$500-\$1000 directly to the student.
